## Why re-roof?

- Broken or cracked tiles and pointing.

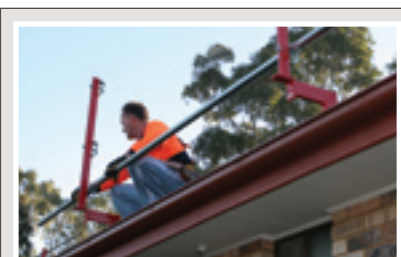
### From an aesthetic perspective re-roofing will:

- Change the look of your home as part of a complete makeover. The roof makes up about 30% of your home's façade, so it has a major bearing on the overall look of your home.

## The Re-roofing Process

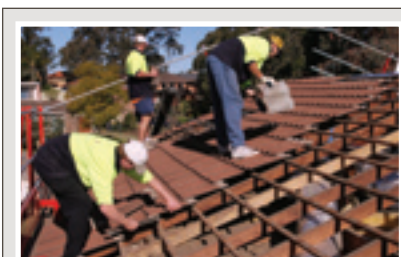
Re-roofing can take 2 to 4 days to complete, depending on the size of the roof.

There are 10 steps to the re-roofing process.



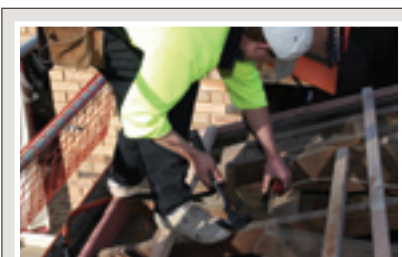
### 1 Install safety rail

Safety is a priority. Before commencing any work Guard-rail is installed around the perimeter of the roof to prevent roof tiles from falling and to keep your family safe.



### 2 Remove old tiles

All the old roof tiles and ridge are removed.



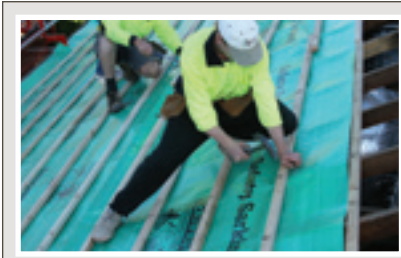
### 3 Inspect roof

The roof timbers are inspected to make sure the battens are sound.



### 4 Install sarking

There are a number of reasons why you should install sarking, it provides insulation and reflects up to 90% of radiant heat entering the roof.



### 5 Install new battens

New battens are installed ready for the new tiles to be laid.



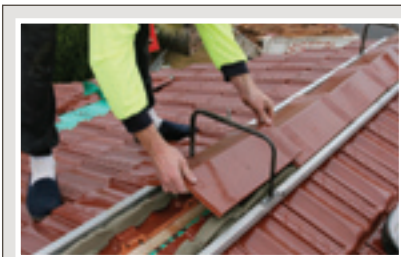
### 6 Load up new tiles

Old tiles are removed and new roof tiles are sent up to the roof using a conveyer system.



### 7 Start laying new tiles

Tiles are laid sequentially up the roof from the gutter line. Fixing clips or nails are used to secure tiles to the roof.



### 8 Ridge tiles installed

Ridge tiles are installed and bedded in place using mortar.



### 9 Pointing

Pointing is a flexible material that covers the mortar and comes in a colour that matches the tile. It acts as a mechanical fastener keeping the ridge in place. It is also used to finish the tiles at the edge of the roof.



### 10 Finish

The Guard-rail is removed, the site is tidied and any left over tiles removed.

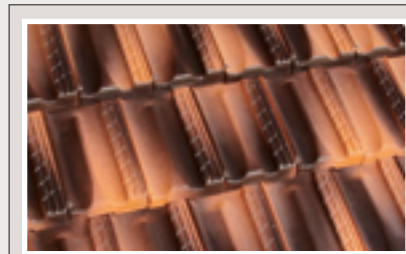

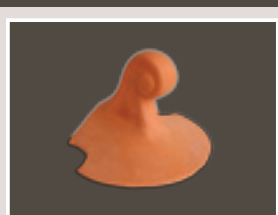
**4-way apex finial ball**  
Finial cap for the intersection of 4 hips.



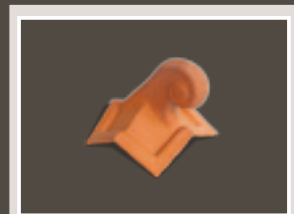
**Chinamans hat finial with ball**  
Used for turret applications.



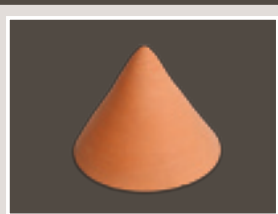
**Spoon apex finial with ball**

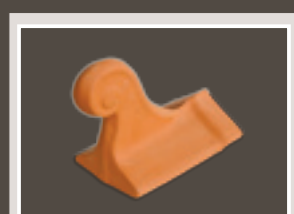

**Product Information**  
The performance of our terracotta tiles is guaranteed for 50 years. However, as a purchaser of Wunderlich terracotta tiles and accessories, it is important to understand the designed performance of our terracotta tiles. Terracotta tiles are created by pressing, glazing and firing of natural clay at over 1,090 degrees Celsius. As each tile is individual to the clay and glaze used, inherently there will be differing shades of colour throughout the manufacturing process. The most attractive roofs are those that ensure a consistent blending of these shades throughout the roof. Touch points and small firing blemishes are inherent to varying degrees, according to the plant of manufacture. These will not detract from the weatherproofing performance of the tile and should not be seen as a product fault.

Colours have been reproduced as faithfully as possible. However actual tile colours may differ to varying degrees from samples shown here. We urge all customers to view tiles on display before making your decision. Always check the delivered product before installation.

**Health and Safety**  
Terracotta roof tiles contain crystalline silica. Repeated inhalation of dust from dry cutting tiles may cause lung scarring (silicosis) or cancer. Avoid breathing the dust. Where power tools are used wear an approved dust mask (respirator). Refer to material safety data sheets (MSDSs) or phone 1800 807 668 for further information.
